This show runs approximately 85 minutes with Intermission. A One Act version is also available.

Load in / Set up

Minimum two hours prior to curtain

Stage

Minimum twelve feet wide and six feet deep

No low ceilings or low hanging lights as performer twirls baton in the air

Simple black backdrop upstage & blacks to create wing on SR side

Stage floor to be cleaned prior to each performance.

Sound

None required. Live musician (fiddler) on stage.

Lighting – competent lighting operator to be provided by venue

Warm wash lighting for stage

One spot and approximately 40 lighting cues – a prompt book will be provided to lighting technician

Set Pieces to be provided by Venue

One sturdy wooden country-style bench measuring approximately 4' L x 14' W

One simple pressed back wooden chair for fiddler

Backstage / Hospitality

Clean dressing room for 1 with full-length mirror

2 clean hand towels

Clean drinking water, coffee, juice (ex: orange, cranberry, etc.), cups and light snacks upon arrival

2 hot catered meals prior to curtain OR a \$25 dinner buy-out per person

Accommodations

If the engagement is more than 100 kms outside of the GTA, accommodations will be required - 2 single rooms in a safe, clean, quality hotel within walking distance to the venue.

Transportation

Ground transportation and flights (if necessary) to be provided by Presenter.

Complimentary Tickets

6 complimentary tickets per performance are to be reserved under the Artist's name. Should these tickets not be required by the Artist, they will be released back to the venue no later than the day prior to the performance.
